FAILING GRADES POLICY

Any of the following may result in a failing grade in an ADN course:

- 1. Failure to attain at least a grade of C in a nursing course based on the ADN grading scale; select nursing courses require an exam average of 80% before other assignments are added to the final grade and overall grade must be 80% (see course syllabus).
- 2. Failure to meet clinical performance expectations and requirements
- 3. Failure to complete all course requirements
- 4. Academic dishonesty
- 5. Failure to meet all safety precautions
- 6. ADN students are required to obtain a grade of C or better based on the ADN grading scale in ADN program courses and the College grading scale for prerequisite and elective courses.

All required coursework from each semester, including semester-required science and general studies courses, must be successfully completed before the student may take coursework from subsequent semesters.
