BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS)/MEDIC FIRST AID REQUIREMENTS

- 1. It is the student's responsibility to obtain/maintain current Basic Life Support (BLS) certification. Current certification must be maintained throughout the entire program.
- 2. BLS must include infant, child, adult, and AED as well as a hands-on exam. Online BLS certification is not accepted in any Health Sciences program.
- 3. Accepted CPR, BLS, and ACLS Providers include:
 - The American Heart Association certification must be "BLS for Healthcare Providers" and requires renewal every two years.
 - The Red Cross certification must be the "CPR for the Professional Rescuer" and requires renewal every two years
- 4. Keep a copy of your current BLS certification. A copy of your current certification must also be kept by the college at all times during your enrollment in the program.
- 5. Students will not be able to participate without current BLS certification.
 - Dental Assistant—required prior to Dental Assistant Clinical
 - Health Information Technology—not a program requirement
 - Medical Assistant—required prior to 2nd semester/term
 - Medical Laboratory Technician—required prior to Clinical Experience 1
 - Nursing-Associate Degree—required prior to 1st semester/term
 - Occupational Therapy Assistant—required prior to 2nd semester/term
 - Pharmacy Technician—required prior to Pharmacy Clinical
 - Phlebotomy—required prior to Phlebotomy Clinical
- 6. First Aid certification must be the "Medic First Aid" for adult and pediatrics. Medic First Aid requires renewal every two years.
 - Dental Assistant—optional
 - Health Information Technology—not a program requirement
 - Medical Assistant—required prior to 2nd semester/term
 - Medical Laboratory Technician—not a program requirement
 - Occupational Therapy Assistant—may be required by some Fieldwork settings
 - Pharmacy Technician—optional
 - Phlebotomy—not a program requirement
 - Nursing-Associate Degree—not a program requirement
