CERTIFICATION

The Medical Laboratory Technician Program is seeking accreditation from the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences (NAACLS). NAACLS is located at 5600 N. River Rd, Suite 720, Rosemont IL 60018-5119; phone number is 773-714-8880; and website www.naacls.org.

Graduates of the program may be able to sit for the Medical Laboratory Technician national certification examination administered by the American Society of Clinical Pathology (ASCP), pending accreditation status. Graduates must take the certification examination within five years of the graduation date.

After successful completion of this exam, the individual will be a Certified Medical Laboratory Technician (MLT(ASCP)^{CM}). All states require certification to practice; however, some states may also require licensure.
