PROGRAM PROGRESSION

General Education and specified ST- Surgical Technology courses may be taken either prior to or concurrently with ST program clinical or skills-based courses. ST program clinical or skills-based courses must be taken in the sequence listed on the Surgical Technology Program Required Course Document.
