Proper Pruning Includes More Than a Good Pair of Shears

Proper pruning can be intimidating, but it really isn't if you know the basics. In this presentation, through the eyes of an arborist we will focus on the overall theory behind pruning, standards, timing, types of pruning and basic equipment. Knowing the proper technique and timing are key to long term health of trees and shrubs. It starts with pruning trees and shrubs when they are young through maturity.

It takes tremendous biological creativity to be a plant. To live and thrive while rooted in a single place, plants have adopted ingenious methods of survival.
