



## UW/WTCS Universal Credit Transfer Agreement - Associate Degree General Education Courses - Transfer Guide

This transfer guide was developed from the Universal Credit Transfer Agreement (UCTA) developed between the University of Wisconsin (UW) and the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS). This agreement applies only to students who are/were previously enrolled at a UW System or WTCS institutions. This guide specifically details how WITC students could transfer credits to UW Eau Claire (UWEC).

Students must successfully complete the WITC course in order for it to be eligible for transfer at UWEC. The transferred credit will satisfy either a general education or general degree requirement at the receiving UW institution and may include elective credit. Students are responsible for working with UWEC to confirm how courses will transfer into their intended major. Students must meet the UWEC admission requirements.

This guide is active for the 2020-2021 academic year.

The UCTA was approved July 2018 and is reviewed biannually.
